

"WHEN CHAOS CRIES FOR HELP"

Daniel Chapter 2

In our text this morning, we have one of those “maybe-God-can-help” stories.

I. A PANICKED KING (V. 1)

The King did what all people do when they hit a situation they cannot control. (vs. 2 - 4)

There comes a point when man’s solutions run out.

The possibility of a supernatural being who transcends human ability becomes relevant.

How then do we respond to the chaos cries for help?

We must first:

1. Realize that unbelievers will approach us!

If you build an authentic, consistent Christian witness, unbelievers in the time of their chaos, will come to you.

II. A PREPARED WITNESS (VS. 12-19)

What Daniel is discretely and wisely asking for here is an appointment with the king.

2. Take the initiative with discretion and discernment.

I didn’t say, “*Call the preacher and turn the unbeliever over to him.*”

3. Solicit support from God’s people.

It is only reasonable that we should go to God and seek His help and guidance through it.

We need strength to do it right.

When the Chaos comes, you need to be ready.
