

# "CHOAS WILL CALL FOR THE BIG CATS"

## *Daniel 6*

**PERSECUTION**, Is there anything you and I can do to prepare?

We should:

### I. NOT **SKIP** A BEAT.

He was one who "*distinguished himself*" among the **others**.

Verse 4 tells us that his **opponents** could find "*no ground of accusation or evidence of corruption*" in him.

You don't wait until the day of the **race** to start getting into shape.

If you've been faithful, you'll continue to be **faithful**.

### II. NOT **STOP** BANGING THE SAME DRUM. (v. 10)

Prayer and thanksgiving were nothing **new** to Daniel. His windows were **already** open.

The **keywords** in that sentence are "*as he had been doing previously*."

Preparation for facing the big trials of life consists of a whole lot of facing the **little** ones.

### III. NOT **SETTLE** FOR SECOND BEST. (vs. 16-23)

Daniel's unabashed trust in God is **obvious**.

Whenever someone fails to trust God in the clutch, it is probably because he hasn't trusted God in the days when the pressure was **lighter**.

David simply kept trusting **Whom** he had been trusting.
