Lynn,

There is no single statement that contains all rights bestowed upon students by the University. However, there are specific rights pertaining to students accused of violating policy found on pp128-129 of the 2006-07 Student Handbook. Additionally, student rights regarding a variety of subjects are interspersed in the publication (and in the catalogue). Examples include the Grade Appeals Policy (the right to appeal a grade), Demonstrations Policy, Student Room Entry Policy, Literature Distribution Policy, Sexual Harassment Policy (all in the Rights and Responsibilities section of the Handbook), and the Privacy Rights of Students (pp21-22).
