In CS 3.4.6 there is an inaccuracy. On page three the text reads:

- The undergraduate psychology program is accredited by the National Association of School Psychologists (NASP).
- The graduate psychology program is accredited by the Master's in Psychology Accreditation Council (MPAC) and meets the standards of training approved by the Council of Applied Master's Programs in Psychology (CAMPP).

It should read:

The graduate psychology program is accredited by the Master's in Psychology Accreditation Council (MPAC) and meets the standards of training approved by the Council of Applied Master's Programs in Psychology (CAMPP). The school psychology option of the graduate program is approved as a specialist-level training program by the National Association of School Psychologists (NASP).

As information, our undergraduate program is not accredited. There is no accrediting organization for undergraduate psychology. In designing our current undergraduate major the Department did use two resources as guiding principles: the American Psychological Association's "Principles of Quality" and the Handbook for Enhancing Undergraduate Education in Psychology. That is as close as we can come to external validation.
