

FMU ALTERNATIVE SPRING BREAK 2010 APPLICATION

The goal of the Alternative Spring Break is to provide students an opportunity to utilize the traditional designated spring break as a vehicle for participating in community service with other FMU students.

Students who participate in the program must agree to the following:

1. Stay for the duration of the alternative spring break – Sunday, March 14 – Thursday, March 18, 2010. The location will be Springmaid Resort in Myrtle Beach, SC.
2. Participate in all debriefing sessions while on location.
3. Participation may include lifting, walking, communicating with others, answering phones, completing paperwork etc. If accommodations are needed, please contact Dean Ramey at 661-1182.
4. Agree to pay for lodging and basic meal plan (breakfast) for the duration. If utilizing the payment plan, meeting all deadlines.
5. Abide all policies and procedures.
6. Placement into the program is on a first-come-first-serve basis.
7. Service organizations must limit participation to no more than 3 members.
8. We plan on taking no more than 20 students. If the number changes, it will be at the total discretion of the advisors of UPB and the Dean of Students.
