

**Vocation: Everybody Has One!**  
**How to Talk About Vocations in the Classroom**

In this vocation presentation, the leaders will guide participants in the use of a series of vocation booklets. These booklets offer step-by-step lesson plans for use in the classroom. Discussion questions are provided at the end of each chapter.

This curriculum is designed to help teachers present the concept of vocation or call to students of all ages. All parents, teachers, catechists and adults interested in vocation awareness are welcome to attend this class. The resources include information on diocesan priesthood, religious life, and includes discussion of full-time lay ministry.
