This is a retreat designed for persons with chronic illness or life-threatening medical conditions. It is a three-day overnight experience of prayer, unlimited hospitality & full nursing care. The retreat is offered free of charge Room and Board along with food/ meals are all provided. The retreat staff members volunteer their time and service and The Archdiocese of Louisville covers operating expenses, including rental of facilities and room and board.

Free will offerings are gratefully accepted. This retreat is open to all faiths/ religions, though it is a Roman Catholic retreat in format, prayer, and style.

This retreat is designed for persons who live with serious & life-threatening illness. It provides time for rest, prayerful reflection & daily conferences. The Eucharist & Sacrament of the Sick are celebrated during the retreat. The staff includes medical personnel in addition to retreat team members who provide hospitality, companionship, & personal assistance for all retreatants.
